


Killed in fires






86 people were rescued from fires


In 2021, 103 people were injured in 76 fires. In 2020, 120 people were injured in 75 fires

Fire deaths, causes of fires




In 2021, only 22% of homes where a fatal fire occurred had a working smoke detector. In 2020, the figure was 28%.
