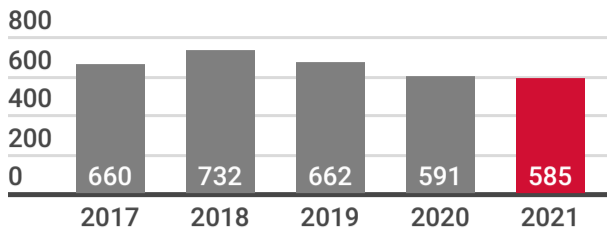
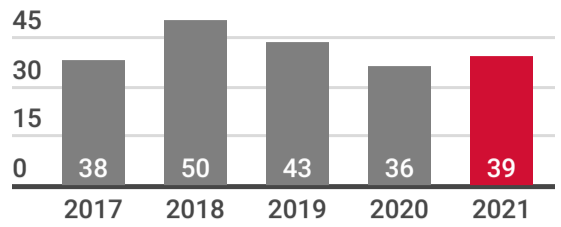

In 2021, 39 people died in 33 fires. In 2020, 36 people died in 33 fires

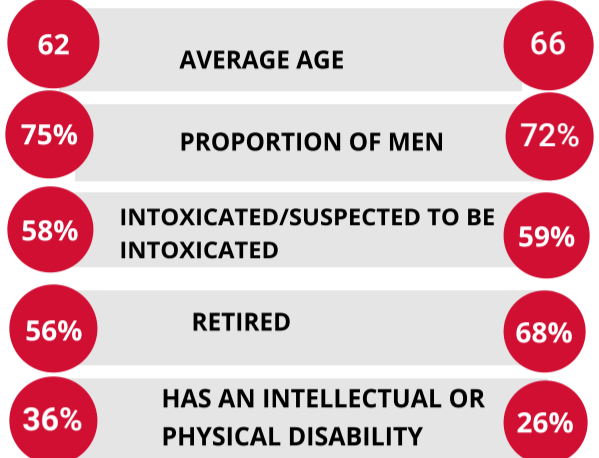


In 2021, 103 people were injured in 76 fires. In 2020, 120 people were injured in 75 fires

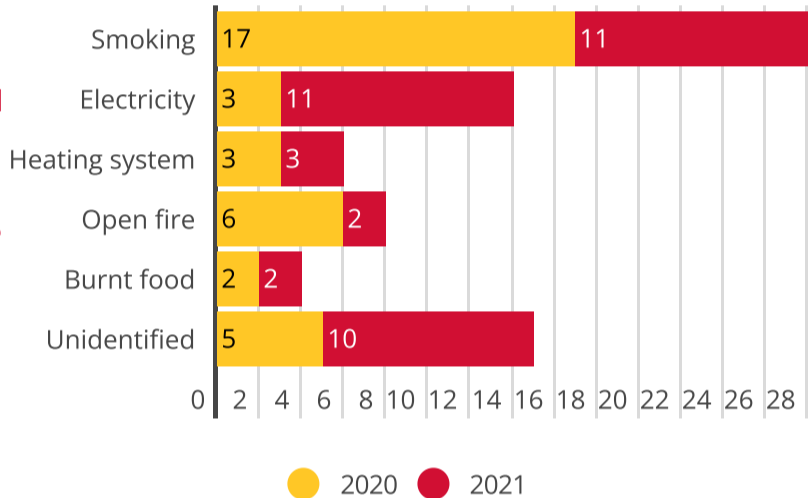

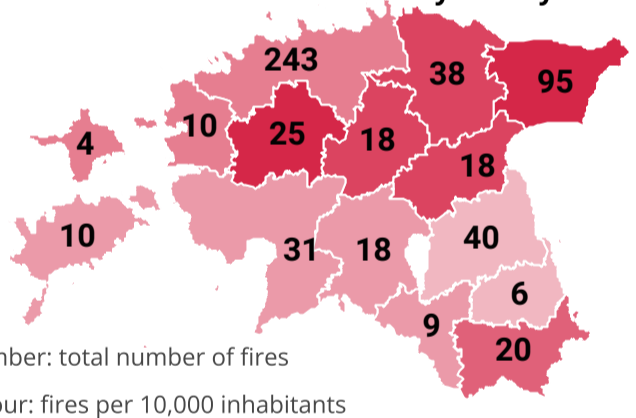
In 2021, only 22% of homes where a fatal fire occurred had a working smoke detector. In 2020, the figure was 28%.

The highest number of residential fires occurred in Harjumaa; however, Ida-Virumaa and Raplamaa had the highest number of residential fires per number of inhabitants
