

Deaths resulting from residential building fires






There were 39 residential building fires in 2022, which claimed a total of 46 victims. In addition, there were two cases in which 2 people died in fires in the outdoors.


Profile of the typical victim of a fire

The most common cause is reckless smoking.



There were 60 residential building fires in which 76 people were injured.




Only 9 homes, or 23% out of all residential building fires that claimed victims, had a working smoke detector.



The primary aid with life-saving capability reached residential building fires that claimed victims in an average of 11 minutes and 12 seconds.

The most common:

Colour: ratio per 100,000 inhabitants

 Malfunctions of electrical installations (weakened/wrong connections)

- Malfunctions of electrical equipment



The most common:

- Careless use of the heating system (combustible materials nearby, improper handling of ash, use of combustible liquid)

- Not following required distances




Fires in occupied and partially occupied residential buildings caused property damage of 5 million euros. The value of property saved was 21.2 million euros.




34,5% of the residential buildings had a working smoke detector.
